I would like to thank you for revising our manuscript: "Complete rectal prolapse in young Egyptian males. Is Schistosomiasis really condemned?" We really appreciate your positive and constructive comments. The two language errors you kindly pointed out have been corrected, these are:

- In Assessment methods: All patients were asked to fill out a questionnaire assessing the duration of the prolapse.
- In results: Four habitual strainers (19%) strained since early childhood.

Both corrections are highlighted in the revised manuscript.

We agree with your comment that the sample size isn't very large, we were aiming at questioning a rather common belief regarding the etiology of rectal prolapse in young males in Egypt and would like to think of this study as a preliminary step, paving the road for more studies investigating this point.
