Thank you for choosing American Journal Experts. This paper was edited for grammar, phrasing, and punctuation. In addition, a number of stylistic changes have been made to improve the flow of each paragraph. Here are several examples of changes that we made:

This manuscript was edited with a specific focus on improving the phrasing throughout the document. In several cases, edits were made to change awkward or potentially unclear phrasing. For example, the sentence "Arpin expression was associated with advanced TNM stage ( $P < 0.01$ ) and correlated with with or without lymph node metastasis" was changed to "Arpin expression was associated with advanced TNM stage ( $P < 0.01$ ) and correlated with the presence or absence of lymph node metastasis". In the revised sentence, the main idea is more clearly presented.

We revised several sentences to express the content more succinctly. In some sentences, a single word can be used to express the desired content. For example, the sentence "At present, the understanding of the multidisciplinary treatment of cancer has been deep into the heart of doctors and researchers" was changed to "At present, understanding of the multidisciplinary treatment of cancer is a concern of doctors and researchers".

Another area in which we made changes was the use of articles (a, an, the). "The" is used before a noun if the noun refers to a specific item. For example, the term "the" was added to several nouns (e.g., "the Arp2/3 complex" and "the gastric mucosa") to indicate that specific subjects were being referenced.

Please refer to the text for further comments and suggestions. Please also note that some changes were made to make statements clearer or more concise rather than to correct grammatical mistakes.
