This Australian Government Research Training Program Scholarship is provided by the Australian Commonwealth Government and the University of Melbourne.

Benefits

The Research Training Program Scholarship provides the following benefits:

- Full tuition fee remission or exemption for up to 2 years for students undertaking a Master by research degree and up to 4 years for student undertaking a Doctorate by research degree.
- Living allowance of \$30,600 per year (2019 full-time pro rata rate) for up to 2 years for students undertaking a Master by research degree and 3.5 years for student undertaking a Doctoral by research degree. The living allowance may be indexed annually and includes limited paid sick, maternity and parenting leave.
- Relocation allowance for students who were living overseas or interstate at the time of applying for scholarship and have not studied at an institution in Victoria within 12 months prior to applying for the scholarship.
- Visa length Overseas Student Health Cover (single membership) for students who require a Student visa to study in Australia
