Crohn's Disease

Medical Condition



A chronic inflammation of the digestive tract.

Rare (Fewer than 200,000 cases per year in US)

Requires lab test or imaging

Treatments can help manage condition, no known cure

Can be lifelong

The exact cause is unknown but heredity and malfunctioning immune system play a role. Common symptoms include abdominal pain, diarrhea, malnutrition and fatigue. Anti-inflammatory drugs and immune system suppressors help in long term remission.

Symptoms

Symptoms range from mild to severe and include:

- Abdominal pain and tenderness
- Feeling of a filled abdomen
- Tiredness

Abstract

One of the most challenging phenotypes of Crohn's disease is perianal fistulizing disease (PFCF). It occurs in up to 50% of the patients who also have symptoms in other parts of the gastrointestinal tract, and in 5% of the cases it occurs as the first manifestation. It is associated with severe symptoms, such as pain, fecal incontinence, and a significant reduction in quality of life. The presence of perianal disease in conjunction with Crohn's disease portends a significantly worse disease course. These patients require close monitoring to identify those at risk of worsening disease, suboptimal biological drug levels, and signs of developing neoplasm. The last 2 decades have seen significant
