The sentence needs language correction. In the 7th and 8th line: "...for reconstruction of bony defects of the upper and lower maxilla..." The term "maxilla" usually means the upper jaw. (The Glossary of Prosthodontics Terms, 6th ed. Mosby) 4. Discussion: Please emphasize the relevance to the general dentist (If there is)
