*This is a systematic review of laparoscopic gastrojejunostomy for GOO in patients with unresectable hepatopancreatobiliary cancers.*

*1. The authors focused on GOO by HPB cancers. In those patients with HPB cancers, a combined malignant biliary obstruction and GOO is an important issue (Dig Endosc. 2017;29:16-25). This topic should be discussed in detail.*

*2. The authors included the studies which included both HPB and non-HPB cancers. However, in most of those studies, clinical outcomes were not separately described. The authors may want to include studies on HPB cancers alone. Or show data of studies of HPB cancers alone and of both HPB and non-HPB cancers separately. Or change the order of Table 2 to studies of HPB cancers alone first, followed by other studies.*

*3. The authors included their own data among their review of literatures. It might be confusing to the reviewers and should be described in a separate subheading.*

*4. Page 8. The authors described ascites was a risk factor for failed clinical success (ref 49). Please add a following paper, which suggested poor PS as an additional risk factor (Dig Endosc. 2012;24:226-30).*

*5. Page 8. A meta-analysis of covered vs. uncovered metal stent was recently published (Dig Endosc. 2017;29:259-271). Please cite.*
