Thank you very much for reviewing our paper. Once again, I reviewed ALK immunostaining together with the pathologist (MT) who was in charge. As a result, the tumor cells were stained for cytoplasmic definitely, but not for the nucleus. As you point out, the NPM-ALK fusion protein is very important, so this time we have considered it thoroughly in the discussion. However, in our case, only G-banded karyotype was performed, and 2p23 abnormalities could not be proved.

1. As stated below, WBC, RBC, CT and so on is an abbreviation.

‘Certain commonly used abbreviations, such as DNA, RNA, HIV, LD50, PCR, HBV, ECG, WBC, RBC, CT, ESR, CSF, IgG, ELISA, PBS, ATP, EDTA and mAb, do not need to be defined and can be used directly.’

2. In this revised version, we added a picture of CT scan. However, because we place importance on PET examination, we leave it.

3. The result of Ki67 index is >80% and added in this time.

4. It was the most time for this revision. The clinical features are summarized in Table 2 for a total of 12 cases of gastrointestinal ALK+ ALCL cases, including 11 patients reported in the past (it became clear that there was one more applicable case) and our patient this time. I think it is much easier to read.

Introduction: I decided to cite 5 articles as a reference.

Treatment, outcome and follow-up: We have reworked in part, but there are no major changes. The limitations and strengths of this case report were discussed in the final conclusion.
