Reviewer # 1

It is a very good review on adult intussusception. 1 There is some misspelling: "As previously mentioned, bowel intussusception afflicts children much more than adults with an approximate ratio of 20 to 1." "entero-X-ray with baryte contrast medium". 2 Note the arrows position in the figures.

1 Scientific quality: The manuscript describes a review of the bowel intussusception in adult. The topic is within the scope of the WJM. (1) Classification: Grade B; (2) Summary of the Peer-Review Report: The manuscript is a very good review on adult intussusception. However, there is some misspelling, which needs to be revised. The arrows position in the figures should be noted; and (3) Format: There are 2 tables and 2 figures. A total of 33 references are cited, including 3 references published in the last 3 years. There are no self-citations. 2 Language evaluation: Classification: Grade B. 3 Academic norms and rules: No academic misconduct was found in the Bing search. 4 Supplementary comments: This is an invited manuscript. The topic has not previously been published in the WJM. 5 Issues raised: (1) The authors did not provide original pictures. Please provide the original figure documents. Please prepare and arrange the figures using PowerPoint to ensure that all graphs or arrows or text portions can be reprocessed by the editor; (2) Please obtain permission for the use of picture(s). If an author of a submission is re-using a figure or figures published elsewhere, or that is copyrighted, the author must provide documentation that the previous publisher or copyright holder has given permission for the figure to be re-published; and correctly indicating the reference source and copyrights.
