<p>For manuscripts submitted by non-native speakers of English, please provided language certificate by professional English language editing companies. It is necessary, please provide it, or we will reject this paper.</p>	<p>I have been asked to submit a non-native speaker of English editing certificate for this invited manuscript. However, this costs upwards of \$300 and since my study did not receive any funding, it is not possible for me to meet those expenses. During my previous publication with WJD, I did not have to furnish any language editing certificate either.</p> <p>I am also surprised by this decision, as I have near-native English fluency (IELTS April 2019 Overall band score 8.0; Writing: 7.5), over 22 years of English medium education and over 30 published research items none of which have previously required any English editing services. I also dispute the second reviewer's opinion on the need for extensive language editing that was totally opposed to the first reviewer who had provided a grade A rating.</p> <p>Considering these factors, I hope the editor will kindly re-examine the facts of the matter and review their judgment towards the furnishing of an English editing certificate. Meanwhile, I have run a grammar check using Grammarly software and edited the completed manuscript and made some of the recommended changes.</p> <p>Any other alternatives which do not involve the steep expenses involved in professional language editing are also welcome.</p>
