I would firstly like to compliment the authors for their article. It is indeed about a very rare condition. The topic is relevant in its field. However I believe the article cannot be accepted as it stands as there are several issues to be addressed. The narrative literature review is well performed and discussed. The language is appropriate. The introduction and methods are appropriate. Results are well presented. The weakest part of the article is related to the very little clinical implication of the paper. Authors failed to highlight why the article should be considered relevant in its fields, peculiarities that could make the article worth of publication, clinical implications, learning points, etc. In summary a more scientific angle is necessary and the article should be restructured accordingly. Basically all aspects related to the relevance of a case report are missing. The discussion needs to be restructured on the basis of the aforementioned issues. The parts related to the literature review are well built and presented. The supplemental material is appropriate.
