SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The authors present an interesting case on a COVID-vaccine induced CVT. The case is a well-fitted example for the clinical practice, where such patients may be easily misdiagnosed. Two minor aspects should be considered before publication of the manuscript -I am aware, that the authors used a commercial language service. However, the English is somewhat off and often includes mistakes that sadly distract the reader from the key message. I strongly encourage another round of English revisions. -Did the authors consider consulting neurosurgery for evaluating this case? While I agree that this patient would not have to undergo surgical therapy at her presentation, the (neuro-)surgical aspects of treating these patients should be considered worth discussing (PMID 34202817)
