The authors in this review discuss the special characteristics of the elderly, the multidisciplinary management of the localized and advanced pancreatic ductal adenocarcinoma and the last advances in the management, focusing on surgery, chemotherapy, radiation and palliative care. The manuscript is well written but very verbose and with different english errors. I suggest the authors to reduce the different chapters of the manuscript and also the paper must be read by a native English speaker. Also in the introduction it should be mentioned that the immune system plays an important role in the progression of pancreatic cancer (references PMID: 23640603, PMID: 25483688 and PMID: 24129765)
