However in my view, the title "Foreign body mimicking Crohn's disease-..." is misleading since the symptoms could be seen in several gastrointestinal diseases and most investigation results (especially endoscopy) is not compatible with Crohn's disease. Suggest a change in the title. For example "Foreign body impaction in sigmoid colon: a twenty euro bet". Suggest following changes in the manuscript in agreement with the above comment.

1. Abstract Move first sentence of abstract " to the first sentence of 3rd paragraph.
2. Introduction Move the first sentence of introduction "Diagnosis of Crohn's... to first sentence of second paragraph.
3. Discussion Suggest revision of first sentence.
