Fibrous dysplasia (FD) is a common benign intramedullary fibro-osseous lesion. Involving the spine is rare with only case reports and extremely rare monostotic FD (MFD) in sacrum. A correct preoperative diagnosis of spinal MFD is important for clinicians to select proper treatment.
