## COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

Authors summarize their contribution in basic research, pre-clinical studies and clinical applications of MSCs therapy in radiation-induced injuries, emphasizing their multidisciplinary approach. The title is appropriate, as it accurately reflects the content of the manuscript. The abstract is brief and clearly defines the aim of the manuscript, that is straightforwardly structured, and written in simple and clear language, although few mistakes are found through the text and require correction. As minor comments: 1. Rereading of the manuscript for a careful check of the manuscript is due, as misprints (including punctuation and capitalization mistakes) are spread throughout the text and sometimes the sense of sentences is missing (i.e., page 2-3, last line on page 2 - 4th line on page 3, "Gastrointestinal disorder management" paragraph). 2. Authors refer to bone marrow stem cells in the first paragraph, to clarify only in page 2 they were referring to MSCs. 3. Second paragraph after the abstract, line 3 Marie "Curie" instead of "Curry".
