The latter sentence should be described in the section of introduction with reference number" The correction suggested has been done

(3) I fully agree with the reviewer on the fact that a table summarizing the biomarker could be useful, but the few works available on literature, which I reported in the review, utilize different parameters to evaluate the biomarkers and often they do not report sensitivity or specificity, thus I can't create a table.
