### COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The authors report a case of gangliocytic paraganglioma (PG) of the duodenum. It is a nice case report with good description of symptoms and treatment of this tumor entity. Due to an average size of 2-3cm of these tumors there are doubts that a PG of 4cm is really already a giant one. Authors stated that to date only a few isolated cases or series of cases are published, which is not correct. Actually almost 200 cases are published already.
