However, some minor revisions should be made to refine this manuscript. Under the topic of "Specific therapies", some subtitles should be indicated such as "Corticosteroid treatment", "Pentoxifylline", "Anti-TNF agents" etc, so as to make the review clearly structured. Besides, the description of N-acetyl cysteine should be clarified into the part of "Specific therapies" instead of "General therapeutic measures".
