Asvestas et Al report a rare case of a patient who presented with headache as the sole symptom of an acute myocardial infarction (AMI). The mechanisms by which headache is linked to ischemic vascular disease remain uncertain and are likely to be complex. There are few data available in the literature regarding the association between primary headache and acute myocardial infarction. The paper is generally well-written and interesting, however more accurate information in some points might improve the paper. Case presentation: 1. Has the patient risk factors, as diabetes, hypertension ect.? 2. Please, specify LVEF and describe whether there were valvular abnormalities. 3. Please, specify laboratory examination, in particular CPK and troponine 4. Please, show ECG after coronary angiography 5. Was the chest X-ray normal? 6. Please, specify the time of coronary angiography after admission of the patient and his pharmacological treatment before, during and after angiography. 7.
