Please note that the introduction section needs to be an introduction and not a methodology. 3. In the methods section, the description of the variable requires unifying information, and where possible please include tables to provide at a glance orientation of the variables. 4. Table 1 would ideally represent the sociodemographic profile of the study population. 5. Table 3 needs reformatting. Not all data from statistical software are to be presented in the manuscript. 6. Strengths, limitations, and implications can be included under respective subheadings.
