(1) To reviewer 0245518: We have expanded our discussion of the Washington State population to reflect the rates of hospitalizations, surgery and percutaneous drainage between 1987-2012. The manuscript reflecting this data is currently under review, and we have cited it as [Simianu and Flum, unpublished data] in the text. If we receive notification of acceptance prior to this manuscript going to press, we will notify you so that we can update the reference.

(2) To reviewer 0245518: Using proportions to explain population-level trends can be misleading – while the proportion of admitted patients having surgery is decreasing, the overall rate of surgery can still be increasing (which is explained by increased hospitalizations for diverticulitis). We have added this wording

in the text to clarify these points.

(3) To reviewer 02445522: We have expanded our discussion of the Washington State population to serve as a population-level case study.
