The hepatic focal lesion had previously been treated with TACE, and in the description of the clinical case , this data was reported. And the histological findings of the hepatic focal lesion was similar to the colonic one: hepatocarcinoma and metastasis of hepatocarcinoma.

Reviewer ID 02-462322:

There are not similar cases in the literature .

A new bibliography note has been added about a recently published work.

Reviewer ID 02860653:

Clinical data were added showing that the lesion was very far from the liver and that we wasn't in the presence of a dolichosigma.

The hepatic focal lesion had been known for several years and treated with TACE. At the time of the hospitalization we did not have US images.

From this clinical case we can learn that even a focal hepatica lesion may be able to give metastases.
