COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

In this manuscript, the authors investigated the prevalence of depression and anxiety in patients with chronic digestive system diseases. They provide a basis for identifying patients with chronic digestive system diseases at higher risk of anxiety and depression, and this will help determine targeted interventions and improve the prognosis and quality of life of these patients. About 1736 patients with chronic digestive system diseases were included. Depression and anxiety symptoms frequently occur in patients with chronic digestive system diseases, especially in patients with digestive system tumors, liver cirrhosis, functional dyspepsia, and chronic viral hepatitis. Elderly patients, divorced/widowed patients, patients with a low degree of education, limited daily activities, poor sleep quality, or a lower BMI are at higher risk for depression and anxiety symptoms. This study is well designed and very interesting. 1 There are some minor language mistakes, the authors should make a revision for the language. 2 The results are good. However, if some figures can be added, it will be better. 3 The references can be updated.
