This is a comprehensive overview of the current epidemiology of gastric cancer with a emphasis on Asia. There is a fair bit of repetition, especially in the introduction. The high incidence of gastric cancer in Asia is entirely due to high incidence in Eastern Asia. Why is this? Whilst the authors provide a nice description of the epidemiology of gastric cancer, I cannot help thinking that they have missed an opportunity to explore this further. H pylori subtypes are touched upon, what about tumour genotypes? Is there a difference in tumour biology? What about different outcomes stage for stage between different populations? And response to chemotherapy/surgery outcomes? Perhaps this could form the basis of further work?
