1. Discussion page 9-10. The summaries in Table 1 were arranged according to the date of publication of the literatures, in which several surgical techniques were used. Even in the same literature, different surgical methods were used. Therefor in the discussion section, we classified the cases reported previously according to the surgical method and analyzed the outcomes of each surgical method. We think this would help orthopedists to choose the appropriate surgical method in case they encounter the similar dislocation of hip.
2. Discussion page 10. We followed your comment to shed more light on the patient recovery. We expanded the discussion on the time of immobilization and non-weight-bearing after reduction. We hope that the present work will meet your requirements.
