Gastric paresis is divided into eight symptoms in traditional Chinese medicine, and deficiency of spleen and stomach qi is one of the most common symptoms. This study is well designed and the results are interesting. Minor comments: 1. The manuscript requires a minor editing. Some minor language polishing should be revised. 2. The limit of this study should be discussed. 3. The references should be edited with PMID and DOI number, according to the journal's guideline.
