00735414	This article was written to highlight the cost of health depicting the utilization of two important healthcare resources by the anesthesiologist in the developing countries - the routine preoperative tests and low flow anesthesia. The author depicts the responsibility of anesthesiologist for these two important cost issues. What's important in the cost issues creation and was not mentioned here is communication with surgeons who are responsible for the utilization of routine preoperative tests by giving to the patients instructions on the types of lab tests. These tests are usually done before the patient meets anesthesiologist for the first time.	Thank you very much for your in-depth review. 	<p>Therefore, communication with surgeons must be in the anesthesiologists' focus of interest by means of reducing these expenditures. The author must stress this communication issue.</p> <p>Regarding the low-flow anesthesia in the developing countries, the author must be also aware that the cost of anesthesia depends also on the type of volatile agent. A choice of drugs also must be pointed. Desflurane is not the best anesthetic to emphasize the cost savings. Especially for short anesthetic procedures where high flows are needed for both induction and emergence of anesthesia. Older anesthetics like isoflurane and even sevoflurane may be more cost-effective. Since low flow anesthesia needs more advanced monitoring it may be not so cost effective for low-income countries.</p> <p>Also, the article needs minor grammar corrections, like Anesthesiologists who are few times written by a capital letter, and a few other mistakes.
