**GENERAL** This is a letter against the review article from Carrera E et al., which were currently published in World J Gastroenterol. Banaszkiwicz A et al. claims that the title of the review would mislead readers because the review mentioned only to “efficacy in vaccination” but not to “efficacy of vaccination”. This reviewer also thinks that Carrera E et al. seemed somehow confused in terminology. Banaszkiwicz’s claim is scientifically meaningful. Additionally, their letter would help clarify the issues on vaccination in IBD patients and provide useful information to readers of World J Gastroenterol. This reviewer thinks the letter from Banaszkiwicz A et al. is potentially worth publishing in World J Gastroenterol as a “Letter to Editor”. **SPECIFIC** The abstract can be deleted if the journal does not request it.
