It is an updated report on the spectrum of pathologies and risk factors for adolescents affected by HIV and thus may represent a useful instrument for readers working in this field, although not specific guidelines are described. An attempts to contextualize the pathologies and the risk factors, affecting HIV infected adolescents , to the lifestyle and to the behaviour in the different geographical contexts would have been of interest. Minor point: references 38-40 and 41-42 are misplaced
