The manuscript is acceptable for publication subject to minor grammatical changes listed below. (1) First sentence of abstract should read: "The availability of highly potent antiretroviral treatment during the last decades has transformed human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) infection into a chronic disease." (2) Page 10 first paragraph, sentence should read: "However, as part of this scenario of improved survival, many youths develop severe metabolic complications, including lipodystrophy, dyslipidemia, insulin resistance, lactic acidosis, and bone mass loss." (3) Page 10 third paragraph, sentence should read: "Multidisciplinary healthcare staff should be aware of the possibility that lipodystrophy may act as a hindrance to ART adherence[8]."
