Animal care and use statement: The animal protocol was designed to minimize pain and discomfort to the animals. The animals were acclimatized to laboratory conditions (23°C, 12h/12h light/dark, 50% humidity, access to food and water). The UC group were induced by 2.5% Dextran sulfate sodium(DSS) solution for one week and then administrated the drinking water another week. In the 14th, all animals were euthanized for tissue collection.
