In this study, the authors reported a 47-year old male with paraganglioma located in the left posterior mediastinum. This study is interesting and clinically relevant, however there are a number of grammatical errors and issues regarding data collection that

The patient's clinical information can be presented in the tables. 3. A long-term follow-up visit, such as 1 year is suggested. 4. Epidemiological information of Paraganglioma in Chinese population should be discussed in the revision text. 5. Treatment options and effects of large-scale research also should be listed.
