Although the rationale of the study of Dr. Zhang and colleagues on the topic of bibliometric analysis of top 100 cited articles in nonalcoholic fatty liver disease research is not really clear to me, the manuscript might be of some interest for the readers of WJH. The language meets the requirements for publication. Although the reviewers raised congruently substantial criticisms and comments, in my opinion, the authors have mainly implemented most of the major criticisms and comments.
