What kind of stem cell markers? 2. Figure 2B is main an image of angle of stomach, which is not very clear for antral ulcer. Would you please change another image? 3. The biological behaviour of gastric carcinoma in child is obvious different from which in adult. However, in discussion, the characteristics of this patient are similar to adult cancer. Please try to find something different in child gastric cancer contributed to more malignant behaviour.
