1. I suggest to supply some imaging (CT scan/MRI) and histopathology to create more interest and make the paper less boring.

We have included 3 composed figures that represent . Classical CT findings before and after steroid treatment in IgG4 RD pancreatitis (Figure 1), PET CT, CT, MRI, EUS and pathology changes associated to IDCP (AIP-2), and PET CT and CT images from a pembrolizumab related acute pancreatitis (figure 3)

2. Figure 1 is influent.

We eliminated the original figure 1.

3. Because of the authors refers to ANCA associated vasculitides but also to SLE, instead of vasculitis I would prefer vasculitis and connective tissue diseases related.

We have modified accordingly. Now in the text it reads ...“vasculitis and connective tissue diseases related Pancreatitis (VasC-AP)...”
