COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The manuscript is a very interesting. In this manuscript, the authors investigated the clinical efficacy and side effects of neoadjuvant chemotherapy in stage III to stage IV gastric cancer. A total of 53 cases of stage III to stage IV gastric cancer patients were enrolled into the study and treated with neoadjuvant chemotherapy. They found that the toxicity reactions mostly included myelosuppression, followed by gastrointestinal mucosal lesions, nausea vomiting and diarrhoea.
