My points all revolve around the English and grammar e.g. should be "plasmacytoma", no colon in introduction (should be a full stop), spelling of "simultaneously", in methods and material first sentence should be "was" not "as" and "for 8 months" and not ago. In surgical procedure section note spelling of "discectomy" and in results need a capital letter for "Twenty". In discussion get rid of the extra punctuation marks after coccyx. In conclusions it should be spelt "which" but also the whole of the conclusion does not actually make sense - it should perhaps be split into two sentences but I still cannot follow your thought processes as your conclusion and qualifying statements seem to contradict.
