In the manuscript "Anesthetic management of a patient with preoperative R-on-T phenomenon undergoing laparoscopic-assisted sigmoid colon resection: A case report", the authors described preanesthetic preparation and management of anesthesia in a patient with previously confirmed preoperative R-on-T phenomenon. The article is well written, covering all parts of the perioperative anesthetic care. No plagiarism was found. The paper was written according to the instructions for the authors. Although there are few published works and instructions for dealing with similar cases, it can be considered original. My suggestions for improving your paper: - specify the days of therapy or doses of Mexiletin the patient received preoperatively. - After this therapy, were any changes observed in the patient's preoperative ECG, in terms of slowing of the pulse, changes in QTc, etc? This manuscript is suitable for publication with minor changes.
