Endoscopic submucosal tunnel dissection seems to be a modification of ESD and not to be an established specific technique, as only a few number of manuscript were found in Pubmed/Medline. The authors must describe why endoscopic submucosal tunnel dissection is an independent endoscopic procedure ? 2. There are lots of abbreviations which are not so popular, such as SESCEN, DETT, STER, EPD, and PLA. Those make readers feel difficulty to understand this review. Minor comments 1. What is 12th in the first line of Page 11 ?
