Endoscopic submucosal tunnel dissection seems to be a modification of ESD and not to be an established specific technique, as only a few number of manuscript were found in Pubmed/Medline. The authors must describe why endoscopic submucosal tunnel dissection is an independent endoscopic procedure ? 2. There are lots of abbreviations which are not so popular, such as SESCEN, DETT, STER, EPD, and PLA. Those make readers feel difficulty to understand this review. Minor comments 1.
