 - (2) The question regarding the identity of the "tumour mass" on tricuspid valve and that this nodule can still be vegetation is clarify by adding the below sentence as follow.


"Although one may argue that the valvular lesion could be due to vegetation and thrombus, they often associated with other complications such as atrial fibrillation, ventricular aneurysm, cardiomyopathy, or infective endocarditis. In the absence of these complications in our patient, the possibility of thrombosis and vegetation is less likely." This is highlighted in the manuscript.
 - (3) Figure 3 is deleted as suggested.
 - (4) The duration of follow up of this patient is clarified in the manuscript and highlighted.

"The patient remained in good health 4 years after the diagnosis and currently still under our follow up. "
