Mekong schistosomiasis occurs in Northeast Cambodia and southern Laos and is a parasitic disease of humans caused by infection with the blood-fluke Schistosoma mekongi (Trematoda: Digenea). The freshwater snail Neotricula aperta is the sole intermediate host for S. mekongi [1]. Although primarily an infection of humans the parasite is also found in pigs and dogs [2,3].
