Pharmacological management of cervicogenic headache typically involves utilization of: 1. antidepressants (specifically, tricyclic, selective serotonin, and norepinephrine reuptake inhibitors) 2. anti-epileptic medications (eg, gabapentin, pregabalin, divalproex sodium, topiramate, carbamazepine) 3.
