Abstract

BACKGROUND

Rhabdomyosarcoma (RMS) is a rare malignant tumor of mesenchymal origin that mainly affects children. Spindle cell/sclerosing rhabdomyosarcoma (SSRMS) is even rarer. As a new subtype, it was added to the latest disease classification of the World Health Organization in 2013. To our knowledge, this case is the first reported adult SSRMS originating from the temporal muscle.
