May 01, 1974 · A **case** of fulminating pulmonary **nocardiosis** is reported. Diagnosis was made before death but too late for treatment to be effective. At **necropsy** extensive multiple pulmonary abscesses with **involvement** of the **pleura**, resulting in an empyema, were discovered. One cervical node showed a similar abscess. No brain lesions nor **involvement** of other organs was seen.
