Severe acid peptic ulcer disease of the stomach and duodenum is manifested as abdominal pain, heartburn, nausea, vomiting, upper GI bleeding, and infrequently, perforation of the viscus. Blood may be observed in vomit or in altered form as black stool. Depending on the amount of the blood loss, symptoms may include shock.

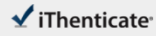
