### Abstract

**AIM:** To determine the relevance of the 10-mm size criterion of the generally accepted surgical indication for gallbladder polyps (GBPs)

**METHODS:** We collected data of patients who were confirmed to have GBPs through cholecystectomy at Samsung Medical Center between January 1997 and December 2012. Among the patients who underwent cholecystectomy for GBP, those with a definite evidence for malignancy such as adjacent organ invasion, metastasis
