Sarcopenia appears to have a **negative impact on surgical outcomes** after hepatectomy, **colorectal resection**, gynaecological **surgery**, and **cardiac surgery**. It was also reported as a predictor of poor prognosis in **colorectal cancer**, [11,15] **oesophago-gastric cancer**, [16,17] **hepatocellular carcinoma**, [18,19] and **pancreatic adenocarcinoma** (PDAC).
