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

Mar 09, 2021 · Limited data suggest that proceeding with **upper endoscopy in patients** with thrombocytopenia is generally **safe**, though whether there is a lower limit below which **endoscopy** should be delayed is unclear. Our approach is to perform an **upper endoscopy** if the platelet count is >20,000/microL, though if the **patient** is suspected to have **active** bleeding, we attempt to raise the platelet count to >50,000/microL prior to **endoscopy**.
