Abstract

More than a century has elapsed since the identification of *Clostridia* neurotoxins as the cause of paralytic diseases. *Clostridium botulinum* is a heterogeneous group of Gram-positive, rod-shaped, spore-forming, obligate anaerobic bacteria that produce a potent neurotoxin. Eight different *Clostridium botulinum* neurotoxins have been described (A-H) and 5 of those cause disease in humans. These toxins
